A Watched Jug never Boils

.... And overfilled jugs take even longer!

Go NOW and check how much water is in your kettle. Mine has less than half a cup. Most people have over a cup.

I have a little bottle next to my kettle. I empty the kettle into the bottle, top it up to the neck of the bottle and put it back in the kettle to boil. Just over 1 cup.

Let's assume you over fill your jug by one cup. It takes an extra minute to boil. 3 cups a day, 365 days a year, that is 1,000 minutes or 16 hours a year.

Not only have you wasted 16 hours of your life during the year, your jug has boiled unnecessarily for 16 hours. Of course your time may not have been wasted, you may have washed the dishes or read my newsletter, but the energy is wasted.

I have seen people have 4 extra cups in the jug. That is just silly!

Now some people boil a full jug in the morning and put the extra in a thermos to use later. That's fine. Some people use a microwave to boil the water and that is fine too, but over filling the jug by a cup is unnecessary.

If your jug needs a minimum of 2 cups of water, buy a new jug.
