Adani Versus Ben Pennings



I normally do not promote Crowd Funding events, but for me this one is different.

Ben Pennings has been around in the #StopAdani movement for many years. He was a founding member of Gallilee Blockade and has been the public face for the organisation for the last 5 years.

Over the years Ben has encouraged others to take non violent Direct Action against the Adani organisation. The effectiveness of this strategy has now resulted in the Adani company suing Ben personally for the financial impact he has had on the Adani company.

This is commonly called a SLAPP suit. Adani has no desire to actually get money out of Ben. They just want to tie him up in such legal action that he cannot continue his protest work. It works because of the enormous difference in wealth and legal power between the two parties.

It is also intended to dissuade others from protesting against Adani. I am happy to protest, be arrested and fined. I am not so hap-

py about losing my house.

I believe we have the right (and even the responsibility) to take Non Violent Direct Action against companies that threaten the future of our world.
